

Stonegate Homeowners Association Trustee

General Information

Responsibility: Trustees: “shall have general supervision and charge of the operation, property, affairs and finances of the Corporation”. (By-laws Article II, Section 1).

- Trustees are also responsible for nominating and electing the officers of the Association.
- The President and Vice President of the Association come from within the three elected Trustees.

Number: The authorized number of Trustees shall be three. (By-laws Article II, Section 2)

Qualifications: All Trustees shall be members of the corporation. (By-laws Article II, Section 3).

Member: A member means a person owning a fee simple interest in a lot. (Declaration, Definitions, 10).

Election: The Board of Trustees shall include those persons elected by the members. (By-laws Article II, Section 2).

Term: Three years

The trustees generally meet after the Membership Meeting and several times during the year as required. They are also responsible for establishing necessary committees and receiving their reports.
